

NX 2312 Windows Install

Note:

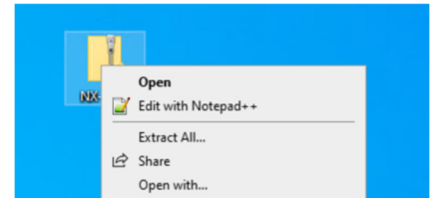
NX download is 14GB and will take some time to download. NX also needs at least 7GB of hard drive space to install. Verify that you have at least 25GB of available space before trying to download and install NX.

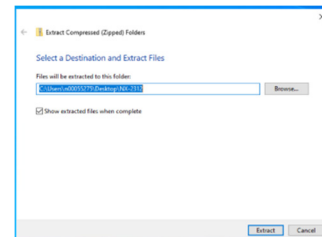
Click NX-2312 Windows 64bit

Click Save and the NX-2312.zip will be downloaded to your Download folder.

Browse to Download folder and right-click on **NX-2312.ZIP** and select **Extract All...**

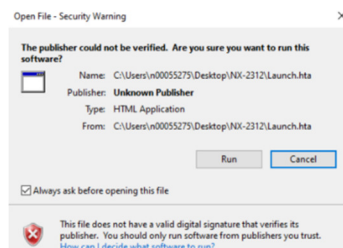
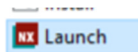


Keep the default location or browse to a new location of your choice.

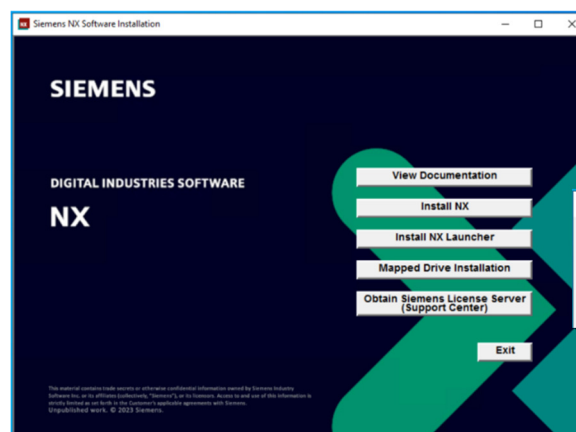


In file Explorer, open the folder ../Downloads/NX-2312

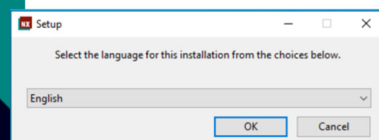
Double-Click Launch application



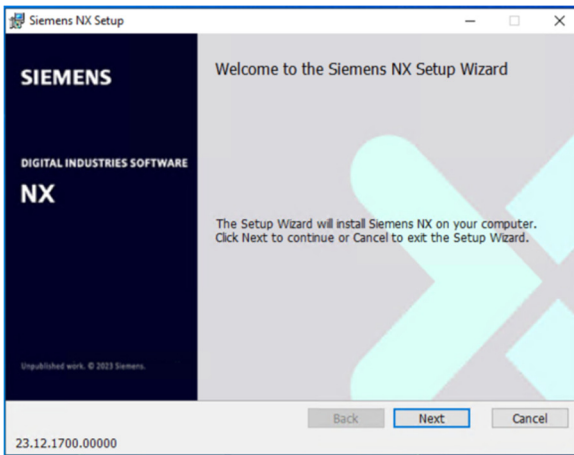
Click **Run**.



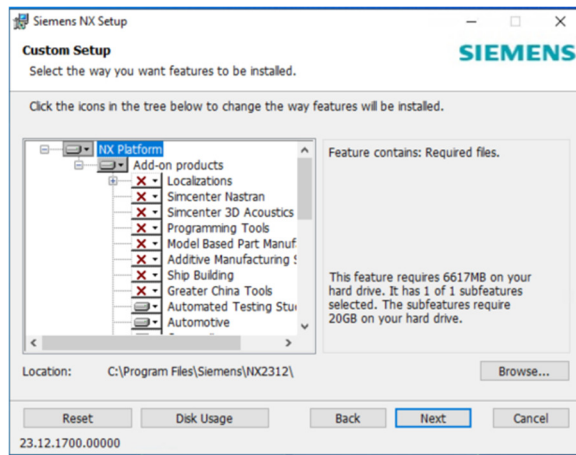
Click **Install NX**.



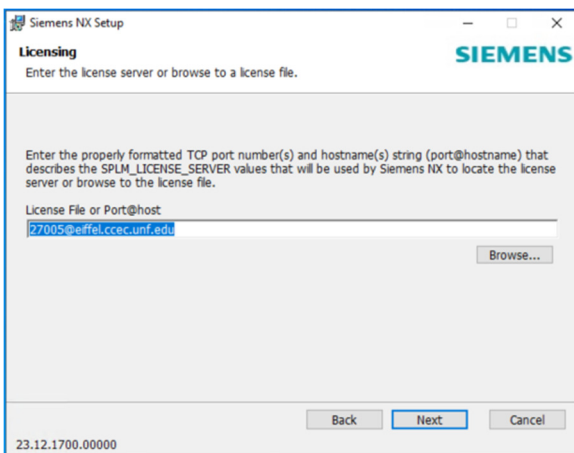
Click **OK**.



Click **Next**.



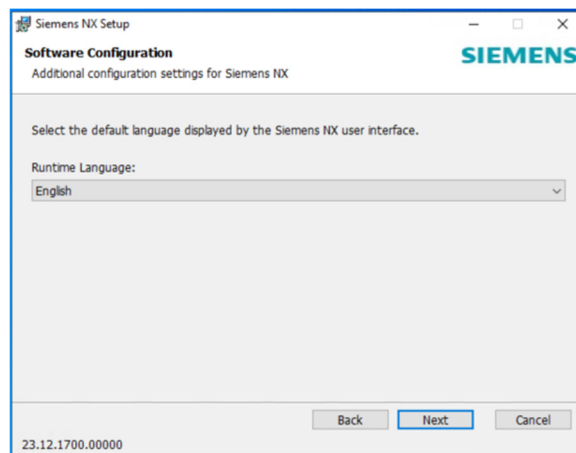
Click **Next**.

and click **Next**.

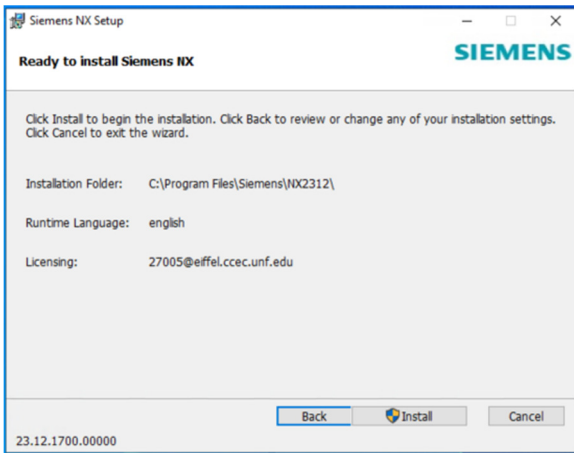

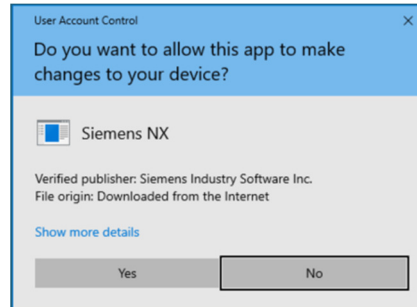
To get a license for NX you must connect to the License Server. The license server cannot be seen off-campus unless you first connect to UNF via a VPN connection using the FortiClient. Click the link below for instructions how to connect to UNF Via VPN.

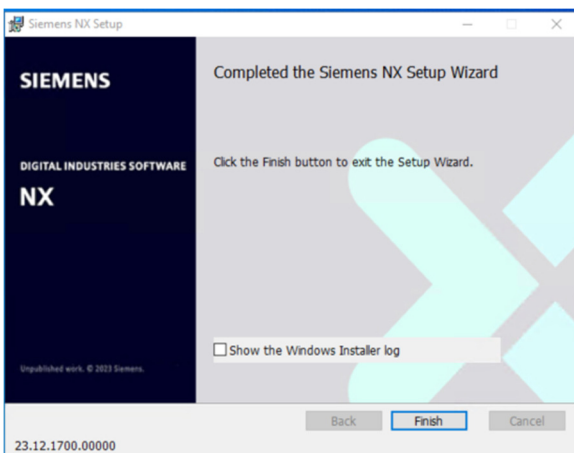
On campus, connect to UNFs wireless network (Eduroam) to access the license server. It is recommended that you be connected to UNF network before starting the NX installation.



Click **Install**.



Click **Yes**.



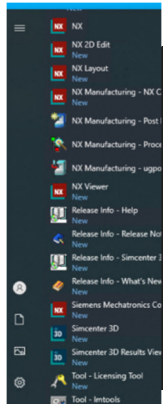
Click **Finish**.

Reboot Computer

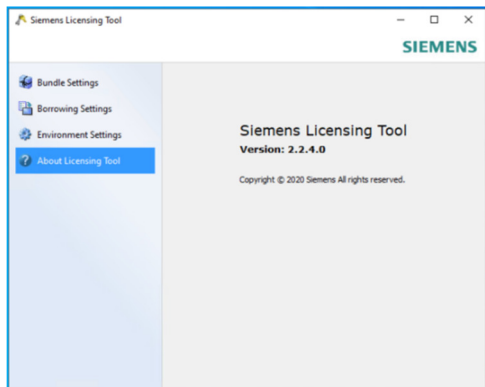
NX 2312 License Checkout

The NX software will work on-campus if connect to UNF Wireless network (Eduroam) or off-campus if connected to UNF via the FortiClient VPN. A license can be checked out to allow the use of NX disconnected from any network.

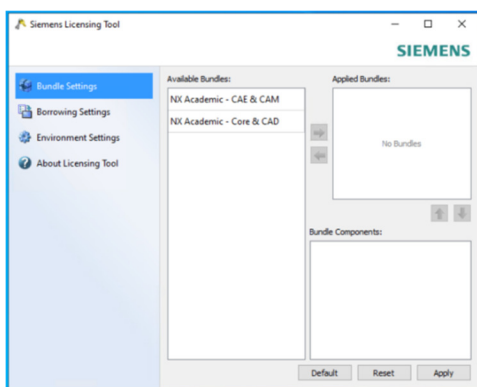
Checkout is not necessary if connected to UNF network via VPN or wireless network on-campus.



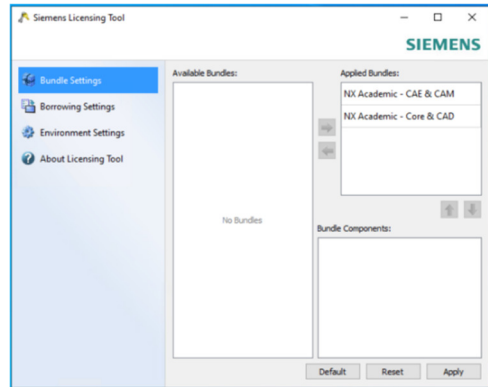
After Reboot, goto Start | Siemens NX | Tool -Licensing Tool



Click **Bundle Settings**.

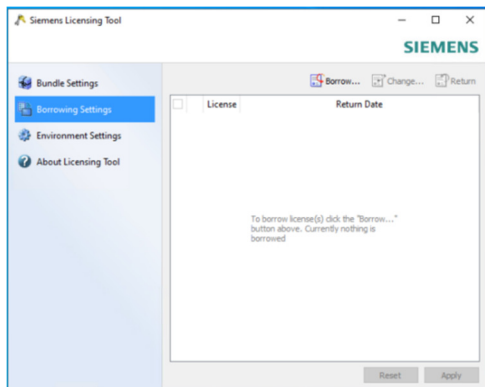


Select each Bundle and click the right arrow (→)to move to Applied Bundles.

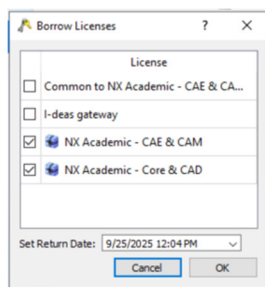


Click **Borrowing Settings**.

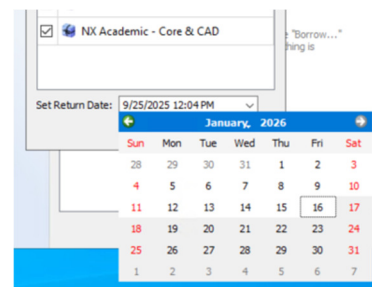
Note: You are not seeing the License Server if there are no Bundles available. Make sure you are connected to UNF via the VPN or through the wireless network. You might also need to reboot.



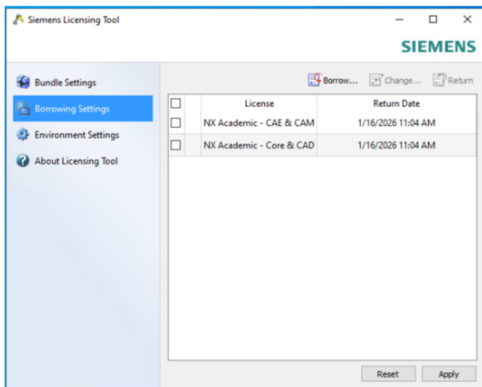
Click **Borrow** above the windows.



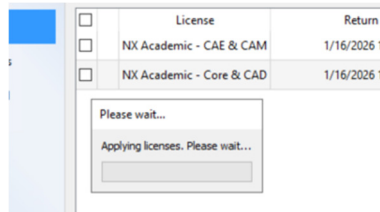
Click both **NX Academic Bundles...**



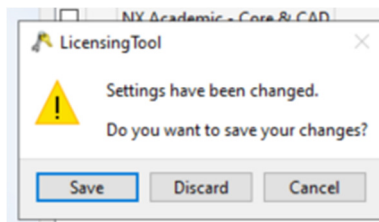
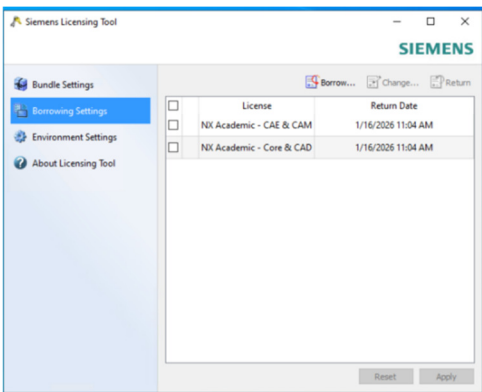
Click the Set Return Date drop-down and and select a Return data that is around 4 Months from current date. Select the last date that has a white background. Dates with grey background are beyond 4 months. Click **OK**.



Click **Apply** to start the Check-out process.



This process can take around **5** minutes.

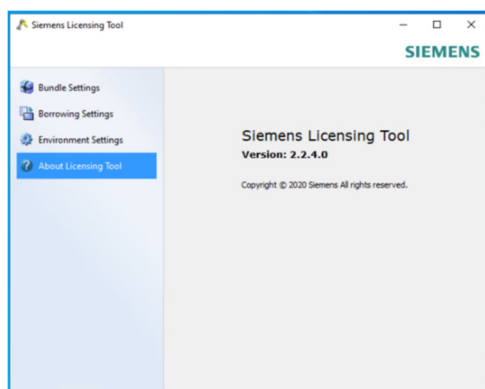


Click **Save**.

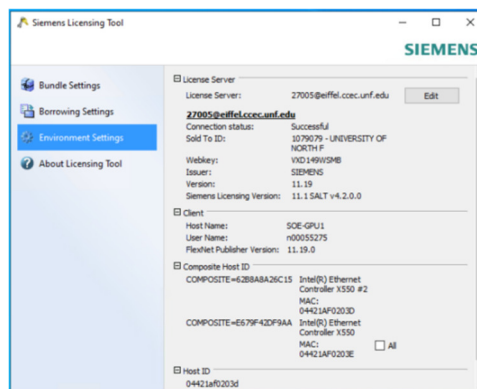
Click  to close dialog.

TroubleShooting Steps

1. Try rebooting the computer.
2. Check that you have the correct license server.
Open Start | Siemens NX | Tool -Licensing Tool



Click **Environmental Settings**.



Verify that License Server is **27005@eiffel.ccec.unf.edu**
Click **Edit** if not correct and enter correct server.
